Grades are based on student achievement, student growth, student participation in testing, and other academic measures. *The COVID-19 pandemic disrupted many facets of education, including instruction, assessment, and student attendance during the 2020-2021 school year. These disruptions may have influenced a student's opportunity to learn, motivation and/or assessment administration conditions. Results presented should not be considered comparable to prior years. 




